There will not be any Ratings or Distinctions awarded at Semi-State. The announcer will first recognize each of the 20 bands who performed at the contest. You will hear every band's name called. Then, the announcer will announce the 10 bands who will advance to State Finals, in performance order. This means we need to hear "North Side" announced as a state finalist before any band who performs later.

Beware, sometimes Evansville North is announced just as "North." Also, there is a North Side, Northview, Huntington North, Bloomington North, and Northridge competing. Be sure to listen carefully and be ready to cheer loud when North Side is called!
